# Who **benefits** from SIRP?

The course is beneficial to parents, friends, schools, juvenile justice programs, and community members who might need support, or provide support to a teen through a time of transition or need.

Those include, teens ages 13-18 who:

- Have been exposed to substance use or abuse in the home
- Have engaged in drinking or drug use
- Have been influenced by friends to engage in risky behaviors
- Are Army, Coast Guard, or Marine Corp policy violators
- Who skip school or are frequently tardy
- Who have experienced money/food/housing insecurities
- Who have moved or relocated or are having a hard time adjusting
